

# 1. How to Get to KAIST

## ❖ Incheon International Airport to Daejeon



- After collecting your luggage, try to exit from Gate #8. There is a ticket booth for bus on your left.



- Purchase a bus ticket to Daejeon. The bus fare is 23,100 won and 25,400 won for a late night bus (after 10pm).



- After you get the bus ticket go to bus stop #9D located across the street. Stand by on the bus stop at least 10 minutes before the departure time. It will take around **2 hours and 40 minutes** from the Incheon International Airport to Daejeon.

- Get off at the “Government Complex Building (정부청사 = Jeong-bu-cheong-sa)” bus stop.

When you get on the bus to Daejeon (대전), please show the following to the bus driver:

**“저를정부청사 내려주세요”**

This means. “Please get me off at the Government Complex Building (정부청사 = Jeong-bu-cheong-sa)”

- ❖ Daejeon Government Complex (정부청사) to KAIST (dormitory)
  - Take a taxi from Government Complex Building to KAIST.  
Please show the following sentence and KAIST map to show your dormitory locations to the driver.

**“카이스트 가주세요”**

This means “Please take me to KAIST.” The taxi fare will be about 5,000 won in normal traffic. Using the campus map in the next page, point at your dormitory and ask the driver to take you off at the dormitory. If your dorm is Hwaam, get a Taxi from Government Complex Building and show the attachment named Hwaam to the driver.
